Since 1993, I acted as clinical lead & director of services. This involves leading on clinical governance, developing new services as well as the operational management of well-functioning mental health and children's services.

I have provided advice and reports to the UK Health Ombudsman in dealing with health service complaints of national significance and to the Home Office on issues of national policy in child protection.

My expert witness experience has involved providing reports and appearing at court in over 600 cases over an eighteen year period.
